The following represents the structure of participation in the Makers Station Glass Blowing Program. Classes are open to 6 participants and are from 7:00 pm until 10:00 pm on Saturday Nights, once a week for a 6 week period. You may register in person, over the phone, or at MakersStationGallery.com

 Student - once a week - \$65 per week for 6-Weeks. (minimum sign up is for a 6-Week period. Total cost: 6-Weeks/\$390)
Saturday 7:00 pm - 10:00 pm

All Classes must be paid for upfront and in full to reserve a seat in the class.

The Cost of our 6 week course includes the use of our glass, materials, equipment, and colors. No purchase of personal equipment is required.

Class Description: This beginner class of 6 students is a course where students will learn skills and techniques in Glass Blowing that include but are not limited to: how to gather, marver, jack, block, add color, and shape the piece. The class will focus on individual skills and we will be working with you one-on-one. Over the course of 6-Weeks, students have the opportunity to make paperweights, ornaments, pumpkins, a drinking glass with a handle, a wine goblet, and a small vase. Please understand that some items are more advanced, and you may not be able to complete all of the different pieces listed. This class is an opportunity to learn how to blow glass and to bring home unique handmade pieces.

<u>Refund/Make-Up Policy:</u> Students will have the opportunity to make-up only one missed class. Our group make-up session will take place on the Saturday following the 6 week course from 7pm-10pm. Any other absences from the course will not be able to be made up and are non-refundable.

<u>What Wear:</u> Please wear **cotton** clothing in the glass shop (jeans and a t-shirt is perfect) as well as closed-toe shoes. Do not wear too tight or loose fitting clothing, long hanging jewelry/excessive jewelry, or synthetic clothing. Hair must be tied back when in the hot shop and eye protection is a **MUST**. If you wear everyday glasses, you are permitted to wear those as your eye protection. We also have safety glasses for you to borrow, and sleeves for arm protection to borrow. Keep in mind, this is a working glass studio, please wear clothes that you don't mind getting dirty, work clothes.
